

## Shelley Johannesen's Cremation

Please join us this **Sunday, May 17, 7:15pm Nepal time, 9am Eastern, 6am Pacific**, for a live stream from Kathmandu.

This service is in respect for Shelley's wishes to be cremated and her ashes carried home and shared with family following the tragic avalanche that took her life while descending Makalu.

This is a traditional Buddhist ceremony. It may be an hour or two of chanting by monks followed by the lighting and burning of the body on an elevated platform. This won't be a polished ceremony, but raw and profound.

The location is along the Bagmati river in Kathmandu, the traditional location for both Hindus and Buddhists to perform cremation. This is a public area with no overhead cover from the weather.

Our Livestream capabilities may be limited in quality from video or audio. But our goal is to share a glimpse of the rich culture in Nepal that Shelley discovered here in a trek to Everest Base Camp in 2022 and has kept her, Dave Ashley, and DASH Adventures clients returning here ever since.

So stay for a minute, stay for the ceremony. You are welcome as you are.
